## Indulge in Afternoon Tea at Wotton House Hotel!

In 1840 Anna, the 7th Duchess of Bedford complained of hunger during the late afternoon. At this time, it was traditional to only have two main meals a day, breakfast and dinner, around 8pm. The Duchess decided a pot of tea, bread and butter and cake was to be eaten privately during the afternoon.

Later she invited friends to join her during the summer for 'tea and walking' which proved so popular that she continued to practice when she returned to London. Other social hostesses of the upper classes soon picked up on the idea and by the 1880s women would change into long gowns, gloves and hats for afternoon tea, served formally in the drawing room. Before long all fashionable society was hosting 'afternoon tea'. Although the ingredients and settings have changed over the years, afternoon tea remains quintessentially British.
